academic and industrial research, natural language processing, communications and media outlets, education, political planning

The master's programmes offers foundations for work in:

- national and international organisations, associations and enterprises (i.e. in companies dealing with natural language technology (e.g., Google, IBM, Nuance or Amazon))

In the M.A. Linguistics: an internship is not compulsory. In the M.A. SLP: an internship during your studies is compulsory (but this can also be done at the university).

Admission requirements

For the M.A. Linguistics and the M.A. SLP:

Qualifying degree with the grade "good" (2.5) or better of a three-year (or more) study programme in the field of linguistics (minimum degree: Bachelor of Arts or equivalent) at an institution of higher education or vocational college.

International applicants need documentation of their German language skills, level DSH-2 or TestDaF 4, or a language test recognised as equivalent.

For the M.A. SLP: Documentation of advanced English language skills (spoken and written English), level B2 of the Common European Reference Framework \rightarrow M.A. SLP can be studied in English
