






Language dominance












Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programmes

Programme line to fund jointly developed and offered teaching/learning projects (new in Erasmus+ programme generation 2021-2027)

- Discipline-specifically tailored projects (e.g. seminars) for Students and Staff
 that have to include
 - A compulsory virtual component (no further conditions defined) and
 - A physical mobility period of 5-30 days (meeting of all learners of the participating HEIs)
- Funding of the project through the coordinating institution, funding of mobile participants through the sending institutions, participating in the project




Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programmes



Funding criteria for the project as such

- Cooperation of at least <u>3 European HEIs</u> (holders of an Erasmus+ charter) from at least <u>3 different programme countries</u>
- Development of an innovative teaching/learning event for students and/or staff that will
- Meet for a physical learning period of 5-30 days in one of the countries the organising HEIs are located in.
- During the on-site meeting, <u>at least 15 mobile learners</u> have to be present, these may be students (BA/MA/PhD) or staff (from any unit of an institution)
 - → Teaching staff within the project/seminar does not count towards the number of mobile learners
- All participants have to <u>be awarded at least 3 ECTS</u> for their participation and possible assignments/assessments (students) and these should be <u>recognised</u> (either curricular or as extra-curricular additional study) at their home institutions.



Roles and responsibilities: Konstanz

- Manual Ma
- General organisation, onsite seminar and social programme, reservations
- Accommodation reservation at the Youth Hostel in Konstanz with full board (2 5-bed and 2 6-bed rooms)
- Support for mobile students in Erasmus+ documentation:
 - Letter of acceptance
 - Coordination of learning agreements
 - Certificates of participation after the seminar has been completed
- Costs for welcome dinner, excursions, coffee during breaks, will be funded through the Erasmus+ funding for BIPs and taken care of through us.

Roles and responsibilities: Sending institutions (your home institution)

- Guidance through administrative steps related to Erasmus+
- Grant allocation and payment
- Recognition of the seminar/ your credits as outlined in the learning agreement




Roles and responsibilities: You as participants

- Check validity of health insurance and whether you would have to add a police to your current one to be fully covered when in Konstanz.
- If you have a liability insurance, do so too.
 We strongly recommend having a liability insurance in place (just in case).
- Book and pay your travel to Konstanz, ideally, you will arrive at the Youth Hostel between 3 and 6 p.m. on the 2nd April 2024, latest check in would take place at 7:30 p.m.
- Submit all Erasmus+ documentation
 - Learning agreements in December still (templates will be sent to you)
 - Certificate of attendance
